Desire simply means to want to be - do –have.

You need to start identifying things you need to achieve in your life. The more you want them so badly, the desire to have them grows in your life. One of the ways to show that you desire something is by thinking and speaking about it most of the time. It is beyond wishing something.

After you have something you desire in your heart, start to SEE it in your mind. Start seeing that you are walking in your desired thing, or you are having it or you are doing it or you are the way you are desiring. To SEE is very important because that is how you activate your mind to receive your desired thing.

To SEE gives you a roadmap of how that thing will happen and that will lead into something very important to bring it to pass which is to add FEELINGS to your desire.

Feelings are emotions that drive the desired thing to come to you quickly. When you desire something and you start seeing it and you start feeling as if you have it now, that thing will come to you or will happen very soon. That is why you are not advised to meditate much on the negatives because as you think of them and feel that bad feeling of worry, anxiety, or anger, that thing will happen soon as you were thinking. Just think only the positive things and put those emotions/feelings as if you have the thing now and you will get your thing in no time.

You need to have faith in this in order to get the desires of your heart. If you desire and see and then no faith or you feel that you might not get that desire then you are nullifying your thing. It will not happen.

After seeing in your mind the desired thing, you need to EXPECT that you are going to get it. Expecting is very important because that is what gives the drive of your desired thing to come to you. It gives it the wheels to run to you. Without expectation, you won't get it.

Hebrew 11:1 (NKJV)

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”

You can have a desire to be healthy, but if your expectation is for you to get worse and worse as the doctor said, then you will get worse.

What are you expecting in life?

for you to travel to abroad.

Another example, you desire to be a public speaker, you see yourself speaking to people and you feel good about it. You expect one day to be a good speaker and deliver some useful information to people. Now take a step of faith by enrolling yourself to public speaking course and learn how to do public speaking. Have that certidcate.

Mark 11:24 (NIV)

Isaiah 52:11 (NKJV)

Many things are happening in the entertainment industry, clothing industry, beauty industry, in schools, at work, in business world and the community, which are done according to the world's desire.

For example, you are an athlete. You have gone to another country to prepare for a tournament. What would you do? Will you pretend that you are from that country and start

to relax and eat as they eat, you go where they go and do as they do?.

Do you stay in their meetings and gatherings as they do? Definitely not. Why? Because you just came to that country with an agenda. To prepare yourself for tournament, which you will participate in that other country. You have no business with the country you are in because that's not a place you will live forever. You are just there for a mission.

This is exactly how we need to live in this world. We need to find out what is it that we are supposed to be doing or not doing while here on earth, which will enable us to live a life in heaven. Our life must be purposeful planned and designed in order to see heaven. Otherwise we will go to hell.

2Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)

“if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”

There are 3 things that you need to do in order for God to manifest in your prayers.

1. Humble yourself

Humble here means to put everything about you away at that moment of prayer as you come to God looking at Him only and depending on Him as your only source. You reduce yourself and lifting God up through worship and praise.

2. Seek

When it's time to pray, you pray putting everything aside and condition your body and mind to obey (humble). After you humble and pray then seeking comes automatically because you already obeyed. As you continue seeking you will know that you need to remove things in your life that hinders you from getting from God.

Remember, prayer makes us closer to God, makes us to know God more and shows God that we trust Him in everything.

1 John 3:17 (NIV)

"If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person?"

Love is action, loving others is expressing your compassionate to them by helping them with what you have. It can be that you have material, money, connection, time, advice and even more your presence. With this definition, everyone ought to love a neighbor because everyone will at least have one of these.

1 Corinthians 13:4 (NIV)

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does

not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth”.

One of the things that will show that you don't pose this Love, is by dishonoring others and disregarding truth. Many people fail to appreciate others for whatever reasons, but keep complaining and angered easily. This is a sign of no Love for neighbor at all.

Colossians 3:12-14 (NIV)

“Therefore, as God’s chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.”

It can be seen in the above scriptures; these are the attributes of love. We need to have compassion to others. This means to show sympathy and concern for others. Kindness meaning to be friendly, generous, and considerate. All these are the attributes of Love because as you possess them you will have the spirit of stretching your hand to others.

1 Peter 3:8-10 (NIV)

“Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble. Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing. For, whoever would love life and see good days must keep their tongue from evil and their lips from deceitful speech.”

We are called to be a blessing to others and not curse others. We need not do evil. If we suffer from doing good then God will bless us and our lives will be a blessing to us and to others.

Hebrews 10:32-34 (NIV)

“Remember those earlier days after you had received the light, when you endured in a great conflict full of suffering. Sometimes you were publicly exposed to insult and persecution; at other times you stood side by side with those who were so treated. You suffered along with those in prison and joyfully accepted the confiscation of your property, because you knew that you yourselves had better and lasting possessions.”

According to this passage we see that love sees greater things than the material possessions of this world. If you have the love of God inside of you, you will be seeing greater rewards, which are from above than these of the world. Everything you do will be based on how God sees you and not your own feelings and emotions. It is important to look only to Jesus Christ and His love, then you will have the love that will be able to radiate in others as well.

Luke 10:30-34 (NIV)

“In reply Jesus said: “A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead. A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other

side. But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him.”

In this passage we can clearly identify what person has the love of God and who does not. Going to church and preach doesn't give you love. All the other two men were people of the church. The Samaritan person chose to love this person by seeing a need and fulfilling it. Love is a choice, it is never a feeling. Let's not look only to our own interests, it's good to accommodate others as well.

Philippians 2:1-3 (NIV)

“Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility, value others above yourselves”

True love needs to imitate Christ's Humility. Christ loved us and gave Himself for us. We need to love others above ourselves.

John 13:34-35 (NIV)

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

The apostle Paul spoke of an anointing of all Christians in

2 Corinthians 1:21(NKJV)

“Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God.”

Christ means the “Anointed One”. Because Christ is in us the same anointing that He had on earth we also have. This anointing is done by the Holy Spirit to us so as to demonstrate God’s love and power.

Every Christian is anointed or chosen by God as His child, set apart for Him for acts of service (Ephesians 1:1-14; 1 Peter 2:9).

You need Jesus, you need the word of God. Every day as you wake up ask yourself what is it that God wants me to do today. What is the word of God for me to stand with in this situation I am in. ing the bible or will remind you a word of God from your heart that will give you authority to trample every work of the evil one in your life, your business, your health, your marriage and your children etc.

You need to make a habit of reading the word every day and meditating on it. When you continue in the word, you will be like what the word says.

Reading the word means beholding Jesus. The more you behold Him the more you will be like Him. The more you become like Him the more the bible becomes a revelation word. Hence all struggles cease. You become more peaceful, in control, loving, helper and all the good things the bible wants you to be.

Ephesians 1:17-18 (NKJV)

“...that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.”

We need revelation word from God through His word because

1. We are naturally blind because of sin. (1 Cor. 2:14, Matt. 16:16-17)
2. We are satanically blind. (2 Cor. 4:3-4)

As we hold on to the truth from the word, the blindness and carnal ways will start to disappear in our lives.

The prayer that every living person should pray is "Open my eyes Lord."

It is my prayer that you ask the Spirit of God to reveal to you the truth written in the word.

SUPERNATURAL LIVING

Supernatural living is experiencing God's
kingdom here on earth.

Living supernaturally is a Holy Spirit empowered living. It is a life that is totally dependent on God's power. It is believing what God says is true, and not what the actual surroundings look like. This is called to live by faith, not by sight as in;

2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV)

"For we walk by faith, not by sight."

The Spirit alone can give life to situations that seems impossible in the natural. And He alone can enable the Christian to keep looking on to God's promises.

Supernatural living is experiencing God's kingdom here on earth. It is living and experiencing as God sees us and not what the situation tells us. This is done in a transformative way through the power of the Holy Spirit working in and through our lives.

By living supernaturally you will experience the following:

God's power

In Jesus, you have been given power to demolish strongholds of evil deception, overcome the controlling effects of the world system, do God's will, fulfill His purposes, and live a holy life.

Philippians 4:13 (NKJV) says,

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

When we allow God's strength and power to work through us we can face life with confidence. God's supernatural power is available to us because we are His children.

God's freedom

We have been set free from the bondage of sin and guilt, the spirit of rejection, the yoke of satanic deception, worry and anxiety, and all fear—including the fear of evil, death, and hell.

God expects us to enjoy the freedom that we have been given in Jesus. If we apply God's truth our life will be free from the bondage of sin and deception, free from worry and fear, guilt and rejection are quickly handled. We will be secure in our relationship with God and in our dependence on His promises.

Most people spend all of their earthly existence trying to make a life that offers these benefits. And yet it is completely impossible apart from God. It is only as we walk in obedience with God and His word, then this kind of lifestyle can become a reality.

God's peace and joy

In Christ, you will experience peace and joy. This is living free from uncertainty.

God's peace and joy is far above our circumstances. God is even more committed to our joy and well being than we are. He expects us to experience a life of peace because we trust Him. It is a peace that can be ours in the midst of crisis and tragedy. But it's only possible to live above the circumstances of our life when you have Jesus as your personal friend.

God's victory

In Jesus, we overcome all things. A supernatural lifestyle is not free of misery, pain and suffering because we live in a fallen world. Adverse circumstances are life's laboratory in which God develops our character. God judges life by the growth of an individual's character, which is manifested in the midst of adversity.

God doesn't expect us to just endure adversity. He expects us to triumph over it. He wants us to trust Him to work in and through our difficulties so that we actually benefit from them. Instead of being destroyed by bad situations or hardships, God wants us to use those hardships to our advantage. No matter what happens, in Jesus we can't lose, because He enables us to be more than conquerors.

3 KEYS TO MAKE SUPERNATURAL, NATURAL TO YOU

Know Your Power Source

Your power source is God. It means to have an intimate relationship with Him. It means He is the first thing you think of when you wake up in the morning, and the last you think of when you go to bed at night. Listening to Him all day, every day.

Listen to God through His written Word and by His Spirit is how you get to know Him. You come to really know the Lord by actively seeking Him above everything else and recognizing Him as your source (Matthew 6:31-33). And, as you begin to know Him-you will begin to know His power.

Believe That with God, all things are possible.
We are working with God Himself. We should expect miracles!

Scripture reveals that truth over and over:

- “With God nothing shall be impossible” (Luke 1:37).
- “The things which are impossible with men are possible with God” (Luke 18:27).
- “...with God all things are possible” (Matthew 19:26)
- “...all things are possible to him that believeth” (Mark 9:23).

We have a vital relationship with the One who makes the

impossible possible. The heroes of faith recorded in the Bible knew God, and they did impossible things.

Soar in the Spirit!

With the help of the Holy Spirit you can “crucify” the flesh (Galatians 5:24) and renew your mind to the Word (Romans 12:2). You can be “spiritually minded” and experience life and peace. Or you can be “naturally” or “carnally minded” and think like the world thinks, and get what the world gets—death (Romans 8:6).

Your spirit is the part of you that is connected to God and can always be in command. When that’s the case, it is not difficult to receive the wisdom or help you need to overcome any situation. When you are connected to the God of the impossible, it becomes easy for the supernatural to thrive.

You can choose to live a limited life in the earth or you can choose to live unlimited. It is totally up to you to choose.

Attend to God’s Word

When we get a one flash of light from the Word of God, it will change our life forever. In order to use the Word of God effectively for our benefit we need to have faith, meditate the word, declare the Word and receive it.

If we do that, we will realize that God said I can have that! As you speak that promise, it will become more real to you than anything else.

When we receive the Word on the inside of us, that is when the natural realm responds. And that is when the supernatural becomes natural.

Ways to tap into the supernatural

Faith

God is waiting on us to respond in obedience to what He has already commanded and already promised. Breakthrough happens when we take the first step against barriers in our life. Breakthrough happens when we say that we are going to trust that God is going to supernaturally do what is impossible. God does the breakthrough, but He's waiting for us to take that first step of faith. We have to believe in God's goodness, that God has already willed the breakthrough for our life.

Prayer

We should actively pray and trust in its power to change our circumstances for good. Your faith life directly correlates to the quality of your prayer life. Prayer has the power to change not only the people and things around you. Prayer also has the power to change you from the inside out.

When you're in need of strength, remember that God is the number one healer and can guide you in endless ways. If your heart and life are centered on Him, His Word and His Holy Spirit. You can rest assured that He will direct your path.

Surrender to God

Let go your fear and let God do the work. When you surrender your life to God, you are following His lead knowing that He's sending you to the right place. You're waiting on God's timing knowing that it will surely come. You're expecting a miracle knowing what God will provide.

You're also trusting God's purpose knowing that He is giving you a bright future. You know you are surrendered to God when you rely on God to work things out instead of trying to manipulate others, force your agenda and control a situation.

In conclusion, supernatural living is all about you seeing a bad situation and reversing it to be a good situation that favors you according to the word of God.

FORGIVENESS

Forgiving is a conscious and deliberate
decision that one needs to make.

Luke 6:37 (NKJV)

“Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.”

Forgiveness is a conscious and deliberate decision that is taken to release feelings of vengeance or resentment toward others who have hurt you, regardless of whether they are right or wrong.

The importance of forgiveness is that it frees us to live at peace with ourself by allowing us to move on without anger, contempt or seeking revenge. Forgiveness is for our own good. When we hold on to hurt, pain, resentment, and anger it harms us more than the other person.

Steps to follow in order to forgive someone who has hurt you.

1. Read the word of God concerning forgiveness. Jesus forgave, Stephen forgave. Meditate on how and why they chose to forgive.
2. Write the name of the person who has hurt you. Send to the Lord by prayer asking God to give you the strength to forgive.
3. Start speaking the name saying I forgive you; I forgive you, I forgive you. Say it loud so that you hear yourself.
4. Deliberately start to love that person. You can also start to look at the positive things they have and dwell there.
5. Repeat this as many times as you can until you see the weight is gone.

If you release them from your heart, you will be set free.
True forgiveness, forgets.

HOLY SPIRIT ENCOUNTER

The Holy Spirit is our Counselor, Helper, Advocate,
Intercessor and Strengthenener.

Who is the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit is the third person in the Trinity. He is the giver of life. His mission is to change every desolate place into a garden of Eden.

It can be seen in the Word of God how the Holy Spirit gives life to people and situations as in the following verses:-

Genesis 1:1-3 (NIV)

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. And God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.”

Before the earth was created there was nothing except the darkness and waters. Life was not in it. The Holy Spirit was there ready to give life to the place. And life came in.

Romans 8:11 (NIV)

“And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of His Spirit who lives in you.”

Luke 1:35 (NLT)

“The angel replied, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God.”

John 16:7-8 (NIV)

“But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. 8 When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment.”

The Holy spirit is our Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor and Strengtheners.

There are things that the Holy Spirit does in us and through us when we give Him the chance, including the following:-

Prays for us (Rom. 8:26), Prophesies through us (2 Pet. 1:21), Bears witness to the truth (Rom. 9:1), Brings joy (1 Thess. 1:6), Brings freedom, Helps us to obey (1 Pet. 1:22), Calls for Jesus' return (Rev. 22:17), Transforms us (2 Cor. 3:18), Lives in us (1 Cor. 3:16), Frees us (Rom. 8:2), Renews us (Titus 3:5), Produces fruit in us (Gal. 5:22-23), Gives gifts (1 Cor. 12:8-10), Leads us (Rom. 8:14), Convicts (John 16:8), Sanctifies us (2 Thess. 2:13), Empowers us (Acts 1:8), Unites us (Eph. 4:3-4), Seals us (Eph. 1:13), Gives us access to the Father (Eph. 2:18), Enables us to wait, Helps us (Rom. 8:26), Guides us (John 16:13). Teaches us (John 14:26), Speaks (Rev. 2:7), Reveals (1 Cor. 2:10), Instructs (Acts 8:29), Testifies of Jesus (John 15:26), Comforts us (Acts 9:31), Calls us (Acts 13:2), Fills us (Acts 4:31), and Strengthens us (Eph. 3:16).

What does it mean to be led by the Spirit?

Meditate on the Word

Joshua 1:8(NIV)

“Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.”

Be the doer of the Word

James 1:22 (NIV)

“Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.”

Put the Word of God above all else

Proverbs 4:20-21 (NIV)

*“My son, pay attention to what I say;
turn your ear to my words.
Do not let them out of your sight,
keep them within your heart.”*

Respond to your spirit instantly. As a born again believer, your spirit is now regenerated by the Holy Spirit of God. Whatever you feel in your spirit man its true. You need to be listening to your spirit and act based on the peace you get inside of you, otherwise you might be contradicting with the instructions the Holy Spirit is giving you. Remember, our spirit sees what is ahead of us. We are living in the natural physical world. Our spirit man sees the

invisible and is led by the Spirit of God to alert us and respond accordingly in this physical world.

How we block the Holy Spirit in our lives

To receive the Spirit's indwelling, you must let go of your intellectual arguments and display childlike faith.

Things that block the Holy Spirit in our lives

Religious tradition. Religious people who are locked into "the way we've always done it" find it hard to receive the anointing of the Holy Spirit. You must be willing to break free from tradition.

Unconfessed sin. The Bible tells us that the Holy Spirit can be "quenched" as well as "grieved" (1 Thess. 5:19; Eph. 4:30). Because He is so holy, our sinful habits and attitudes can cause Him to withdraw.

An unyielded spirit. You cannot be filled with the Holy Spirit if you are full of yourself. Some people are too willful. They have not surrendered their plans, finances, relationships or time to God. They have their lives planned out and they don't want God interrupting their agendas. Yet God is looking to fill hearts that have been emptied and surrendered.

Start a Holy Spirit relationship

How do you have an individual relationship with the Holy Spirit?

Get to know Him as a good friend. Spend time with Him. I got to know the Holy Spirit by spending quiet time with Him. I would put in soft, worshipful music and soak in His presence. Soaking is sitting, kneeling or lying quietly and allowing His Spirit to speak to you and minister to you. The Holy Spirit desires us to stop what we are doing and direct our undivided attention to Him. He wants our attention in these moments of intercession. He helps bear the load when we are praying to the Father. When we don't know how to pray or the right words to say, He drops revelation and knowledge into our spirit man of what and how to pray. In Romans 8:26, Paul speaks of how the Spirit Himself takes part when we pray. He assists us in praying in the natural until the spiritual prayer rises up.

Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Spiritual gifts are supernatural empowerments given by the Holy Spirit to the followers of Jesus Christ. He gives Spiritual gifts so that they can do the work of building up the body of Christ and extend the Kingdom of God throughout the world.

Baptism in the Holy spirit

In order to be baptized in the Holy Spirit, first you need to desire him. You need to want his leading and be ready to surrender to his guidance, council and recommendations upon your life. The Holy Spirit is not antagonistic toward other members of the Trinity.

He has come to glorify Jesus Christ (John 16:14), summon people into the kingdom and demonstrate the will of the Father on Earth.

The Holy Spirit was the emphasis of some of Jesus' final words on earth, as the Son of God shared about the transition that would take place after His death and resurrection. He would be ascending to heaven, but another Helper would come (John 14:16). It is of great importance to be filled and baptized with the Holy spirit because Jesus saw that it is important as He said in His last words to the disciples. Wait. Wait for the indwelling of the Holy Spirit so as to get power to do all that I have taught you.

At this moment the Holy Spirit is already here on earth waiting for you to desire him and let him come to you and dwell in you and work in you and through you. Remember, you cannot produce good fruits for God without the help of the Holy Spirit.

The blood of Jesus Christ is a physical blood shed by Jesus who is the son of God in order for humanity to get salvation of their souls as well as to get healing from all diseases. One needs to believe in Jesus Christ, receive him as personal savior, trust the work he has done on the cross at Calvary - the shading of His blood to remove sin, guilt, shame and bring healing to our mortal bodies.

There are many advantages in the blood of Jesus that one needs to know and understand in order to start applying it every day.

Blood is widely used by many throughout the scriptures and even in our modern day. Sacrifices of animals and even human beings are done in order to get the blood for different agenda.

But what does the blood of Jesus Christ mean to us?

His blood redeems us

There was a price that we could not all pay due to sins, transgressions and iniquities we have done and those we have inherited from our fore fathers. But the blood of Jesus has redeemed us. Redemption means the action of saving or being saved from sin, error, or evil.

1Peter 1: 18-19 (NIV)

“For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.”

His blood cleanses

The blood of Jesus Christ removes the punishment of sin, but also removes the pollution of sin and cleanses us from all unrighteousness. If you are cleansed you are made pure and holy. It is important to apply the blood every day to cleanse your soul, body, surroundings, food, house, properties, medicines etc.

1John 1:7 (NIV)

“But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.”

His blood has power

There is power in the blood of Jesus to overcome Satan and his hosts. Satan doesn't want you to learn about the blood of Jesus, it is the blood of Jesus that Satan fears.

Revelation 12:11(KJV)

“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.”

Use the blood of Jesus every day to overcome the devil and he will flee from you.

His blood makes peace with God

By nature, Man is at war with God. We can only come to God and reconcile with Him through His peace terms – the blood atonement.

Colossians 1:20 (KJV)

“And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things on earth, or things in heaven.

The blood of Jesus removes the guilt and shame that rage war in our souls. But when we apply His blood, we get peace with in our souls and with God.”

His Blood brings us into fellowship with God

Ephesians 2:13 (NKJV)

“But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.”

It is important that before you start worshiping or praying to God, to ask for forgiveness and plead for mercy. Then start to appropriate the blood of Jesus from your head to your toe, your surroundings and even for the things and people you are praying for. In that manner you create a good atmosphere for you and God to have meaningful and powerful fellowship together. We are living in the world which is polluted by sin, hate, anger and all sorts of things that make us not worthy to be in God's presence. But cleansing ourselves in the blood before anything else will make God see the blood and be able to come near us and fellowship with us.

John 4:23 (NKJV)

Worshipping God in spirit

True Worshipers worship God in spirit. God is spirit, so in order for us to reach Him, we need to have passion, love and intensity to draw him in the spirit through the help of the Holy Spirit of God. God is in a place of peace; we also need to be at peace in our hearts in order to worship God. It is very difficult to worship God when you are in pain and sorrow. Even if you are experiencing a bad situation in your life, you need to first give all the burdens to Jesus who will heal you, then you worship God.

It is our way to magnify God through our human limitations. The spirit is our deeper connection with God when we receive Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. Its where there is peace, joy and love.

Worshiping God should be a lifestyle, an everyday act that glorifies the Lord. Not an experience like during a praise and worship gathering where you listen to songs then you worship.

Romans 12:1 (NIV)

“Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.”

Worshiping God is an act of offering our bodies to please God. Sacrificial living is denying the flesh/body and its desires and passions that do not please God. It is from the inside out (from the spirit/heart) and not from the outside in (from how you feel).

We worship God everyday by:

1. Doing what is right even if everybody else is doing wrong.
2. Loving God and neighbors.
3. Setting Godly examples wherever we are.

Worshiping God can be manifested in deeds in your office/business, at home, in your relationships and at the market place. True worship is when others see your God and experience Him through you. Living a life of worship is a total surrender to God in everything, in every way and to every situation that will please God.

Worshipping God in Truth

True worship comes from the spirit. This is a place where you find TRUTH.

God is truth, and if we act according to his Word, we are worshipping him. If we act according to our ways, we are not worshipping Him. If you pray according to your feelings of trauma, anger, pain and sorrow or bitterness of life, you are not worshipping God. This is because you have not yet reached him. God is in a place of peace. Let go and let God direct in your life. Worshipping in truth is to take what is true of God and to apply it in our lives like:

1. Forgiveness (we need to forgive others)
2. Love (we need to have agape love towards others)
3. Give (We need to help others)
4. Trust God (believe that God will make a way for you)

Let us live by the truth of God so that people see who our God is and not what our situation is.

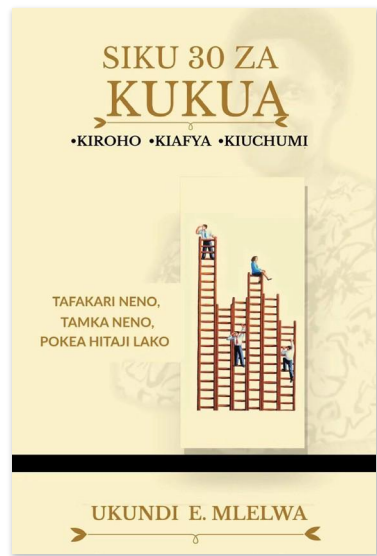
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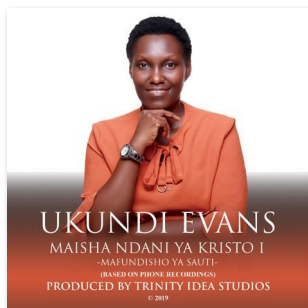
